## **BDH Chief Executive Officer**

Boort District Health (BDH) CEO, Dr Darren Clarke, has advised that he will be leaving the health service at the end of September. Darren will be relocating back to South Australia for family reasons due to the ongoing uncertainty associated with the COVID-19 pandemic, particularly around interstate border closures. Darren is commencing a Local Health Network role with SA Health in early October 2021.

Announcing the move, Darren indicated that "it has been an absolute privilege and pleasure to have been part of the leadership team at Boort District Health since June 2017. Together, we have made significant progress across our entire health service and I remain very confident that BDH will continue to develop and excel as it embraces future opportunities. I sincerely thank the Board, our staff, volunteers, local community and our colleagues across the broader health system for their constant support and collaboration throughout my tenure as CEO at Boort District Health."
