

# Can someone ask me to remove my face mask to check my ID? Yes.

You can remove your face mask temporarily to have your ID checked when required by the law.



Police, banks, post offices and other services such as retail, can ask you to remove your face mask to confirm your identity



When purchasing alcohol or tobacco you may be asked by staff to remove your face mask as part of checking your ID



Once your ID has been checked, you must put your face mask back on, covering your nose and mouth. Face masks protect you and others from the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19)
