The Hospital is not funded as an Emergency Department and those presenting will be triaged or assessed by Senior Nursing Staff and if necessary, treated by the Doctor on call.

The Doctor will charge the patient accordingly.

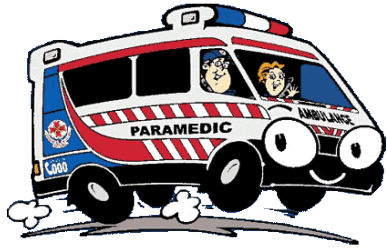

AMBULANCE TRANSFERS



Did you know - the cost of an Ambulance Transfer from Boort District Health - Urgent Care Centre is **not met** by the Hospital?

If you do not qualify for any of the exemptions below **YOU** will receive an account from Ambulance Victoria which could be \$4,000

- Ambulance Victoria members subscription holders
- Pensioner Concession Card holders
- Health Care Card holder
- Traffic Accident Commission - TAC
- WorkCover

OUT OF HOURS MEDICATION

1. Medication supplied to you as an Outpatient is provided by the Hospital in a starter pack.
2. This Medication will only last until a prescription can be filled by the Pharmacy.
3. To continue your medication treatment you will need to visit the Pharmacy during business hours to get your prescriptions filled.

BOORT MEDICAL PRACTICE - GP

The Boort Medical Practice provides 24 hour care for patients on a shared roster system with GPs from this and neighbouring practices.

AN “OUT OF POCKET” COST OF \$30 IS CHARGED TO PATIENTS SEEING THE DOCTORS AT BDH REGARDLESS OF ANY CONCESSIONS.

1. Please ask for a Medicare Form while waiting for the Doctor.
2. Please fill in the Medicare Form and sign.
3. Please hand it to the Nurse.

An account will then be sent to Medicare on your behalf by the Boort Medical Practice.

You will receive a cheque from Medicare that will need to be forwarded to the Boort Medical Practice along with your out of pocket cost of \$30.
